GRADE C DECONTAMINATION

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THE PROCESS

Guardtech will perform a pre clean inspection to determine the initial contamination level before conducting 5 stage clean as outlined below:

Stage 1: Vacuum all floors with HEPA filtered vacuum cleaner.
Direction of vacuuming – start in the cleanest cleanroom, working backwards through the facility (highest grade to lowest grade cleanroom, corridors, change room/materials transfer interlock). Team exit through the stepover/change room.

• Vacuum all floors and ledges and underneath stationary equipment.

• Empty all bins and put new bin bags in bins.

Stage 2: Sterile Neutral Detergent clean with mops/qipes of all areas and surfaces.

• Ceilings, then qalls, then floors mopped.

 Surfaces wiped by hand.
 Direction of cleaning as per Stage 1, paying attention to corners, edges and ledges.

 All surfaces at all levels to be cleaned. **Stage 3:** IPA clean with mops/wipes of all areas and surfaces.

- Ceilings, then walls, then floors mopped. Surfaces wiped by hand.
- Direction of cleaning as per Stage
- 1, paying attention to corners, edges and ledges.
- All surfaces at all levels to be cleaned.

• Focus on stainless steel furniture and equipment.

Stage 4: Following the decontamination a visual inspection will be performed. Particle counts will also betaken to demonstrate that the facility is compliant with ISO 14644 requirements. **Stage 5:** A comprehensive and detailed report will be provided following every clean conducted.
